

# Apron

## Made from a Shopping Bag



### How To Do It

#### Materials Required:

Large plastic or paper shopping bag, scissors, stapler and staples, tape.



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### How To Do It:

1. Cut off one handle.
2. Split the remaining attached handle in half at center top.
3. Overlap and staple the "removed" handle to the split handle at sides, adjusting length.
4. Cover staples with tape.
5. Make a center vertical cut (top to bottom) on the side of the bag without a handle.
6. Cut away the bag base along the bottom and sides for Child's apron. Leave extra length if making Adult apron.
7. If sash ties are desired, cut away excess bag above and below the 3" wide sash, as shown. Close sash at back with clothes pin, paper clip or similar.
8. You should end up with something that looks like this.
