Materials Required:

Scotch tape, scissors and optional Tacky Glue. Copies from "original" supplied. (1) 10 Oz. or 12 Oz. plastic cup cut in half, lengthwise. *Optional* chenille stem for nose ring.



Attach chenille nose ring, if desired.



- How To Do It:**
1. Cut 10 Oz. plastic cup evenly in half, lengthwise. *12 Oz. cup works too.
 2. Cut out all remaining parts.
 3. Place snout face down. Position $\frac{1}{2}$ cup over snout and tape two longest tabs together at center back side.
 4. Fold three end tabs into center.
 5. Position mouth of cup on lower portion of Bull's face. Cup's crescent rim matches to lower face at corners.
 6. Tape center snout tab onto bull's face.
 7. Tape remaining tabs into place.
 8. Use scissors to clip $\frac{3}{4}$ " in at both sides of nostrils. Fold nostrils down and secure to bottom (end) of cup with a small piece of rolled tape.
 9. Bend into a crescent shape and attach "optional" chenille stem nose ring with tape. Ole'
