## Materials Required:

Chenille Stems, instruction sample sheet for small kids and optional scotch tape.

## How To Do It:

1. Bend stem in half at center.
2. For small kids: tape the stem at center over the paper sample. Bend into "M" shape and then curl as desired, like samples.



### OR

1. Bend stem into a "V" shape, then into an "M" shape. Tweak your "M" by straightening and curling the ends.
3. Points insert into your nostrils. Fasten by lightly pinching at center. Painless; removable.



## Connection to Dalí

Dalí wore the same style of moustache as Velasquez, who was the court painter for King Phillip IV of Spain. The King thought his moustache was so cool that he made everybody else wear it too. Who do YOU look like?
